LOJACK REVEALS TOP STOLEN AUTOMOTIVE RECOVERIES OF 2009

Proven Stolen Vehicle Recovery System Helps Police Bust Chop Shops, Recover Stolen Cars Undamaged...and Get the Bad Guys

Westwood, MA —December 16, 2009—LoJack Corporation (NASDAQ: LOJN) today unveiled its wrap-up of the year's top recoveries of stolen cars, trucks and SUVs that were equipped with the LoJack Stolen Vehicle Recovery System. These recoveries demonstrate how LoJack's Radio Frequency technology—which operates even if the vehicle is in a concrete garage, steal container or hidden in dense foliage—and direct integration with police help law enforcement bust major chop shops, recover vehicles unharmed, and arrest the thieves behind these and other more serious crimes.

Below are LoJack's top recoveries for 2009:

- **“Most Stolen and Recovered Car”** – Officers with the Detroit Police Department were notified of a stolen 2009 Cadillac Escalade after an opportunistic thief swiped it from an auto repair garage. In just 34 minutes, police recovered the stolen vehicle. ***This is the third time in six months that the Escalade was stolen and recovered.*** In all three instances, the vehicle was recovered in less than three hours thanks to police and the LoJack System.
- **“Biggest Automotive Chop Shop Bust”** – In this recovery, a LoJack-equipped Toyota Tacoma led California Highway Patrol and Anaheim detectives to bust a massive Toyota Tacoma truck chop shop – comprised of more than ***50 trucks valued at over \$300,000 —and arrest five criminals.*** Police used a combination of the LoJack Stolen Vehicle Recovery System to track down the stolen vehicle and the LoJack SCI InTransit tracking and monitoring device to monitor the thieves' every move in order to crack this major case.
- **“Best Long Distance Recovery”** – In this recovery, a Toyota 4-Runner was stolen in Las Vegas and recovered by the Pomona (California) Police Department – ***more than 300 miles away*** from where it was stolen. Four suspects were arrested.
- **“Best Recovery Demonstrating Long-Term Effectiveness of LoJack”** – Like Timex, LoJack just keeps on ticking. In this recovery, a 20-year-old LoJack system helped the San Francisco Police Department recover a stolen Mazda 626.

The owner, who purchased the vehicle used, had the pleasant surprise of discovering his vehicle had a LoJack when he reported the vehicle stolen!

- **“Speedy Recovery of Monster Truck”** – A Ford F-250 4x4 Monster Truck valued at \$70,000 and equipped with the LoJack System was stolen and recovered by police – unharmed -- *just eight minutes* after activation. The Riverside (California) Police Department and Riverside Sheriff’s Jurupa Station arrested the suspect who was a parolee.
- **“Best Arrests”** – In one recovery, a suspect was arrested by the Baltimore Police Department for *attempted murder*, armed carjacking, auto theft and resisting arrest after he beat an owner of a LoJack-equipped 2008 Chevrolet Tahoe with a baseball bat and stole his car. In another instance, police tracked and recovered a 2009 Toyota Highlander stolen by an *escapee from a New Jersey correctional facility*. The suspect was arrested by the Gloucester Township Police Department along with three other people.
- **“Recovery of the Most Expensive Vehicle”** – In this recovery, the owner of a Mercedes Benz SL65-AMG equipped with the LoJack System reported the vehicle stolen to Bakersfield Police Department in California and *within just 14 minutes* of activation this \$220,000 vehicle was recovered undamaged. Deputies also discovered one pound of marijuana upon searching the residence.

And, on the Lighter Side of Vehicle Theft...

- **“Convicted Car Thief Steals Car to Attend Arraignment”** – You just can’t make this up: In this California recovery, a *convicted car thief* actually stole a LoJack-equipped Range Rover in order to get to court for his arraignment on previous car theft charges. Vallejo police and officers with the California Highway Patrol tracked down the vehicle and arrested the thief for yet another car theft!
